National Specialty Week

Montgomery week isn't just conformation for Kerries, there are lots of other fun activities as well! For anyone who may be planning their first trip to the USKBTC National Specialty week, please consider adding a day or two to your trip and come to Palmyra, PA to see Kerry blue terriers in the multiple events held at the "In the Net" facility.

The Montgomery Terrier Agility Cluster (MTAC) has become my favorite agility event since I first attended with my Lakeland Terrier ten years ago. Briefly, the Montgomery Terrier Agility Cluster (MTAC) is multiple days of terrier-only agility trials with days hosted on a rotating basis by the various terrier parent clubs. Held annually since 2000, the MTAC is held on the weekdays prior to the Sunday terrier-only conformation show known as "Montgomery". This event started as a one-day trial in 2000, expanded to three days in 2001, and in 2005 to four days. The MTAC was held outdoors at Kimberton, PA until 2014, when it moved to an indoor site in Palmyra, PA (near Hershey, PA). Stephanie Capkovic of the West Highland White Terrier Club was the initial organizer of the MTAC, and the Westie club hosted the first trial in 2000. The US Kerry Blue Terrier Club has hosted a day of the cluster in 2005 and 2014. An obedience trial was held for a few years at Kimberton, but then no club stepped forward to host further obedience trials. The clubs brought back obedience and rally last year in 2015, and plan to have obedience and rally again this year. In addition, for 2016 two clubs have stepped forward to host Barn Hunt and Lure Coursing during various days of the MTAC.

Many of our Kerry friends made the trip to attend this fun 4 day event long before I was ready to trial there. In past years our breed was well-represented with a good turnout. While most of us loved the outdoor site at Kimberton, PA, entries the last two years MTAC was held there dropped drastically in all Terrier breeds, likely due to time, travel, expense, and the unpredictability of weather at the outdoor venue. However, instead of abandoning this unique competition limited to Terriers, several years ago the MTAC planning committee made the bold decision to move the venue to "In The Net", an indoor soccer arena in Palmyra, PA. In The Net is a beautiful facility, known as one of the best indoor agility sites on the East Coast because of its great turf, lovely site and spacious arena.

This year the 4 day MTAC event takes place from October 3-6, and is bigger and better than ever before in its history. There will be agility, obedience, rally, barn hunt and lure coursing - something for everyone! I hope more performance Kerries will be able to attend this year, as our representation isn't anything like it was in years past. For agility we give out beautiful USKBTC medallions and a gift certificate for high scoring Kerry in 4 levels each day, as well as for high scoring Kerry over all 4-days. Even if you aren't ready to try agility, rally, obedience, barn hunt or lure coursing yet, please try to plan a day to watch and support the many talented performance Terriers attending MTAC! Hope to see you there!

Nurture the Next Generation of Fanciers

Have you ever checked the average age of your breed club's membership? I am sure you will not be surprised to find out that the average age is probably from 55 to 70. It is important for the continued support of the breed to promote and nurture the younger generation of breed owners.

What are some of the things clubs can do to support the younger generation of dog owners? Following are some ideas.

1. Have a list of breed mentors who are willing to answer questions any younger new owners may have. Often a quick phone call can help a younger owner tackle an issue. Hopefully, the responsible breeder of their dog fulfills this role and supports, advises, and involves the new and young owner of the many options open to them, from conformation to performance events.
2. Run a handling and grooming clinic for any new owners, and offer special awards to the young participants under a certain age (to be determined by the club).
3. Offer young owners (age to be determined by the club) club membership for free or at a much-discounted rate.
4. Compile a list of young handlers, and make it available to club members so that they can offer support and encouragement.
5. Make sure each breed club has a young member coordinator, and use this person as a re-source for coordinating activities that would appeal to younger participants.
6. At breed specialties, offer the youngest family members of participants dog-related coloring books or breed books. The AKC has coloring books available for purchase, as well as breed and health information and dog books.
7. Run contests for the best children's drawing, photo, or cartoon of their dog. Publish the winner on the club website and newsletter. Having specific age limits for participants is necessary; you can include categories like 3-6, 7-12, and 13-18 years, and 18 and over. Offer awards in each age category. Similarly, you can hold handling or grooming competitions. Offer these younger breed owners a number of paid dog show entries as incentives or awards.

8. Breed clubs should support Junior Showmanship at shows or performance events by sponsoring breed trophies for younger participants.

9. Mail out activity sheets and the breed standard or handbook to young members. (The most difficult problem, which I will not tackle, is having your breed club decide on the age limit for what your club considers a "young member.")

10. Run a writing contest with a suggested topic or theme, such as "Me and My Dog." Offer prizes, and publish the winning compositions.

11. Establish a scholarship foundation. Suggest that each chapter club establish a scholarship fund, then combine the funds and distribute to multiple winners at the national specialty weekend.

12. Offer breed health information, coloring books, and the breed handbook or breed artwork to younger members participating in conformation and performance events.

In addition to what breed clubs could do, much of a younger person's interest in the breed and AKC events must start with the support of the child's own family. The family may include all the younger family members in any dog events they may be participating in. The family helps to transport the younger members to various events, offers financial support in the form of supplies and event entries, and involves them to help the adult participants in all dog events.

As Ben Franklin said, "Tell me, and I forget; teach me, and I may remember; involve me, and I learn."

The future belongs to the young. Help them prepare for their involvement! For more information, visit the USKBTC website, at <http://www.uskbtc.com>.

Vacationing with your Dog

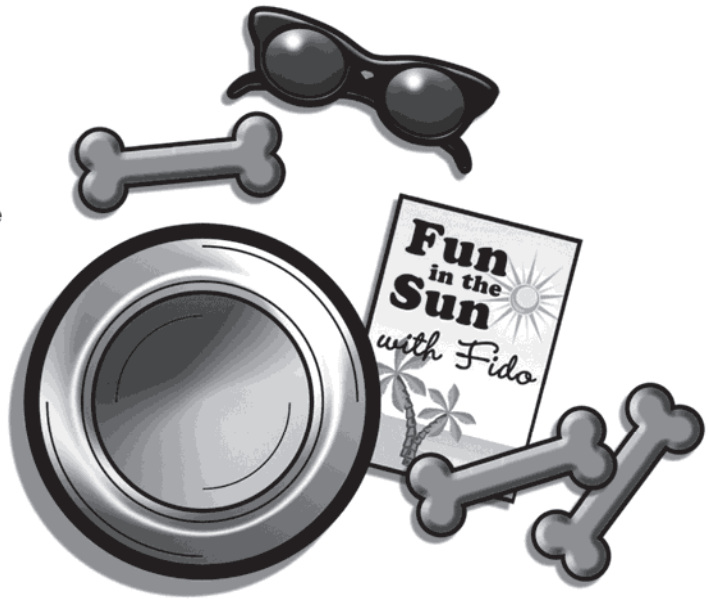
We all know that our dogs are creatures of habit. My little guy will wait in the same spot, on the same rug, at the same time, each and every morning until I fill his bowl. He'll then retreat to the same bed, and lay at the same angle while he takes his same, post-breakfast nap. He's like clockwork. So why is it any wonder that a spontaneous three-day vacation to a quaint beach town five hours away is going to mess with his clock? Stupid human.

As the one behind the wheel, who knows the destination and knows that the pet-friendly rental we're headed to isn't going to be infiltrated by nefarious ninjas during the night, it's easy for us to kick back and enjoy the ride. But what about our dogs? How can we make their vacation more pleasant? How can we give them that sameness that they so crave, when things aren't the same at all?

Step one – take the sameness with you!

Bring along items that are familiar to your dog as part of his everyday routine to show him that his entire world hasn't been turned upside down. It might be a good idea to designate your dog his own bag and include items like:

- *Food and water bowls from home*
- *An adequate supply of your dog's regular dog food*
- *Water from home. Often times, particularly in cases where your home relies on a well, dogs can grow selective about what type of water they will and won't drink. Since we often travel to populated areas, treated water may be the only type offered in your vacation rental and*



the new mix of chemicals may disagree with your dog's nose and his tummy!

- *Your dog's "at home" bed, or if that proves too bulky an item to transport, a blanket or towel steeped in familiar smells. Think about where your dog will be sleeping in his temporary digs. Will he snuggle up beside you in bed? Will there be enough room to suit you both (as well as any other family members)? If he's banished to the floor, will he still be comfy?*
- *Some toys and chewable items from your dog's "personal" collection.*
- *A crate/carrier? If your fur-ball typically sleeps in a crate at home, the likelihood is that he derives a great deal of security from doing so. Introducing him into an unfamiliar environment and then at the same time expecting him to do without that security is a tall order! Your "relaxing vacay" may prove less than restful if you're cradling a nervous dog in the wee hours of the night!*

- An extra leash (and harness, if you typically use one). You never know when the suitcase gremlin will make off with your primary one.
- A towel, because, let's face it . . . puke happens.
- A raincoat (weather dependent).
- A life jacket if you'll be encountering water during your outings.
- Any prescription medications your dog is currently taking.
- Treats, because you KNOW your pup is going to get distracted...squirrels, seagulls, dozens of new dog bums to sniff. How could one possibly stay focused?
Wait . . . did you say "Liver?"
- Enzymatic stain/odor remover. After all, even a fully potty-trained pet can suddenly have a lapse of memory in an unfamiliar place. And since you're walking into

a space that's undoubtedly been used by many dogs before, what are the chances that they were all perfect angels?

- Grooming supplies for those high-maintenance kiddos that require a daily brush-down.
- Doggie first aid kit because--porcupines, epic jumping opportunities, exotic, hungry insects, sharp bone-shaped sticks that are utterly irresistible, and on and on.
- Poop bags.
- More poop bags.



Some of the items packed in your pooch's getaway bag may be a comfort to him, others to you, but either way, you'll both be better prepared for the adventures to come by planning ahead. And while planning ahead entails a careful examination of what you pack in your "doggie bag," packing is certainly not the only factor to consider when traveling with your pet. Many of us don't travel with our dogs frequently enough to realize some of the hiccups that can arise while travelling. And even those who do travel regularly with their furry kids may find that requirements differ from venue to venue. Revisiting some of the basics, along with the oddball circumstances that can arise during a vacation, can help to prepare one and all for unexpected situations.

Step two – plan ahead!

Some (quite literal) bullet points to remember when preparing for a multi-day outing:

- *Make 100% . . . 110% . . . 120% sure that your rental venue is pet-friendly. What would you do if you showed up, arms full of bags and rockin' the Hawaiian shirt and Ray Ban's, and the clerk at your hotel gave your furry fella the stink eye and turned you away? That would be one long, depressing drive home!*
- *Ask about mini-fridge availability in your rental if you feed raw food. Chances are that the concierge isn't going to offer to put your raw beef next to his sub sandwich in the employee fridge just because you didn't do your due diligence when booking.*
- *Check to make sure that you don't need a health certificate for you pooch at your rental destination, or simply to cross between any states included in your travels. Having a current health certificate (which can be obtained from your veterinarian) on-hand whenever you travel with your pet is a good idea, but if you don't want to get one, just make sure you aren't going to incite a red-light lockdown quarantine when you walk in the door without it.*
- *If you can manage it, researching your destination beforehand and compiling a list of pet-friendly locals in the immediate area is a*

dandy idea. As progressive and pet-friendly as some sites can appear, you might be surprised when you and your dog actually step off the property and venture into the area surrounding your rental. While a layperson may assume that any outdoor venue is one that would welcome your well-behaved pooch, many areas (including a laundry list of state parks) impose restrictions on canines. There are a host of fabulous books currently available whose authors have compiled lists not only of pet-friendly rentals in particular areas, but outdoor destinations as well. You can fork out the money for one, or just do some sleuthing online if you're pinching pennies.

Many seasoned dog owners are well versed in the restrictions of the atypical pet-friendly rental, but for someone new to the game, you may be stunned to learn that the "pet-friendly" label isn't quite as "friendly" as it might seem. Most standardized rentals (I'm speaking of motels, condos . . . anything that you aren't casually renting from some gal you met at the water cooler during your break at work), would be better described as "pet tolerant" than "pet friendly." This means that while they welcome your pet, they don't really trust him. They don't want to be friends, so much as just casual acquaintances, who never hang out alone together. What this means for you is that while Fido is permitted to hang out in your room, the second you step out that well-worn peep-hole pinned door, he's officially worn out his welcome. The bulk of pet-friendly rentals have a "no pets in the room alone" policy that restricts you from leaving your pet in the room unattended. While this may not seem like a major deal on the surface . . . trust me . . . it is. And it warrants some pre-planning to be accommodated. Remember that fancy seafood restaurant on the pier . . . the one you went to when you were on your honeymoon . . . with lobsters the size of footballs and scalloped potatoes so creamy that they melted in your mouth? Well, sorry to break it to you . . . but you can't go. If Fido can't go, you can't go.

I know what you're thinking. I'm making this whole "traveling with your dog" thing seem increasingly less appealing. But wait—it doesn't have to be! Just take a bit of extra time during your planning

phases and that luscious lobster may still be within your reach! Perhaps you've got a 12-year-old built-in doggy-sitter? Maybe you have friends nearby who'd like some quality time with your pooch? Where there's a will, there's a way!

**Note of warning—don't try to get sneaky! Even if you brought a crate and decide that tucking your pooch away in it and discreetly positioning him on the far side of the bed is a surefire path to creamy, creamy potatoes—you're wrong! Most rentals will fine you a hefty amount if the innocuous housekeeper (who, with your luck, loathes dogs), discovers your precious furkid hidden behind the bed while you're away.*

Step three- EXERCISE, EXERCISE, EXERCISE!

That 5-hour car ride is going to be significantly more enjoyable with a passed-out pooch at your side rather than one who is frothing at the mouth and smattering your car windows with snot rockets at every intersection. Still, once he hits the beach, all bets are off!



DREADED AIR TRAVEL

You know it—that sickening feeling that creeps into your gut when the topic of air travel is mentioned. The lines, the carry-on restrictions, the pat-downs . . . it's like taking an hours-long tour of Hades itself. And yet it could be worse! Swap your perfectly permissible two human legs for four furry ones, slap on a tail, and suddenly you've become a second class citizen. Most airports treat dogs like a contagious disease, mandating that they be bottled up in a kennel, chucked into cargo and otherwise manhandled. But some airlines, those of the more progressive and pet-friendly ilk, are changing all that. Let us all rejoice with a howl!

JFK's Luxury Pet Terminal

Picture it with me—an enormous, crystal-blue

swimming pool teeming with happy faces. A fine lookin' lady lounges poolside while a frisky young buck stares at her from the deep end. It could be the scene at any vacation hot spot, until you notice that the pool is bone-shaped and the lovebirds are golden retrievers!

Yes siree, give it another few months, and JFK Airport plans to make this tail-wagging mirage a reality. The ARK at JFK will be the first luxury pet terminal offered at an airport, and promises to offer their annual 70,000 or so non-human flyers with amenities, such as spa therapy, massages, "pawdicures" and big-screen TVs where pets can watch their owners traipse about the terminal. Set to open this year, the \$48 million dollar facility will cater to an array of furry travelers—including dogs, cats, horses, goats, cattle, pigs, sheep—even the occasional aardvark! Of course everyone will be provided with their own custom-designed space, but surely the bone-shaped pool is destination numero uno for any of our readers! Still, if you're planning to indulge in this progressive, state-of-the-art facility, you'd better bring your checkbook along. A flight to London for a dog can cost about \$1,000, plus the cost for a crate, veterinarian certification and airport fees.

Sit 'n Stay Global

While you've got that checkbook out, why not opt out of the commercial air terminal altogether and let a private jet whisk you and Fido away? Sit 'n Stay Global allows its flyers a FURst Class experience, be them human or dog-kind! Pampered pooches who fly these friendly airways will find that they can roam freely through the cabin during flight while enjoying amenities like dog-centric catering and pooch-friendly in-flight entertainment. In addition, Sit 'n Stay Global boasts itself the only company that provides safety equipment on board for pets—such as a DOT tested safety harnesses, life jackets and pet oxygen masks.

Touchdown in Reality

Okay, so it's fun to dream, but most of us can't

afford to shell out a cool thousand (plus) to get our furry kid from A to B. Alas, the traditional method of flying with our dogs rears its ugly head and stares us down with a sneer. We find ourselves glaring back, realizing that the best we can do is to keep our dogs safe and make sure they arrive on the ground in one piece. That's where the planning begins.

In-cabin flight (fit for the wee ones)

Double, nay, TRIPLE-check your airline's carry-on pet guidelines! Most of the major airlines (Alaska Airlines, JetBlue, American Airlines, United, Delta Air Lines, Southwest) have set up sites that outline their pet parameters, but in all cases you're going to need a note from your veterinarian stating that your dog is safe to travel. You're also going to need a carrier that will fit comfortably under your airline seat, the measurements of which vary from airline to airline. Get out that tape-measure and get to work because friend, if it won't fit, you're in a world of hurt at takeoff time!

Know the fees and book early!

Since airlines typically limit the number of pets that can travel on any given plane together, it's smart to add your pooch's name to the roster before all the available spots fill up. Also, airlines charge a range of fees for travelling with a pet (typically anywhere from \$75-\$125), so be prepared to open your wallet along with your stockpiled patience when you walk in that terminal.

Consider Upgrading.

You think that airline seat was a tight fit before? Wait until you've got a hard, plastic carrier jutting out under your feet and knocking into your shins. This may be one of those instances where forking out a bit of extra dough for a larger seat with more leg room may be worth the investment.

Strategize!

Got a full bladder-empty it! Got a thirsty pooch-satiate it! Got a howler who needs his favorite rope toy to calm him-bring it! Remember, once

you arrive at the airport with your furry travelling companion, things are going to get hectic. Plan ahead and take some of the edge off.

Arrive at the airport early (but not too early)!

If traveling with your pet seemed like the more convenient travel option for you, consider your convenience card tapped out. Many of the (sometimes) simplest parts of air travel, like checking in at a kiosk or whizzing (OK-so that's a stretch) through security just became more complicated. Pets must be checked in with a counter agent at the airport so that they (and their carriers) can be weighed and measured. This means waiting in line and wrestling with a potentially unreceptive measuring participant, which takes TIME. You factor in the extra minutes it'll take to pack and unpack your pet from his or her carrier as you suffer through the X-ray detector scan (which can be done only after your pet is free of his enclosure), and you're under the gun even more so. Throw in a couple of bathroom stops for your Nervous Nelly, and you may just be running down that plane if you don't afford yourself some extra time.

Cargo Flight (for our larger friends)

The Great Debate

There is, has been, and most likely will continue to be, a bevy of debate regarding the transportation of dogs in cargo holds. While many unfortunate (and often deadly) incidents have incited the improvement of safety regulations pertaining to animals transported in the cargo area, there are certain camps that still maintain it is unsafe. The Humane Society of the United States (HSUS), for example, lists air travel as "unsafe for pets,"

and is particularly critical of any travel that involves a cargo hold. Still, being well aware that thousands of Americans are forced to transport their dogs in this manner on a regular basis, HSUS suggests that flyers do their research and check out their airline's track record with

cargo-hold-based animal injury and death prior to flying. Since most airlines are required to report any such incidents to the U.S. Department of Transportation, they can be easily accessed online (<https://www.transportation.gov/airconsumer/air-travel-consumer-reports>).

When it's Cargo, or no-go

Sometimes, cargo truly is the only option and while your gut may be quaking at the mere thought, doing your due diligence with regard to preparation can quiet some of those butterflies. Follow these tips and silence your inner-worry-wart:

- Use direct flights
- Always travel on the same flight as your dog
- When you board--notify the captain and at least one attendant that you have a dog in the cargo hold.
- Don't ever transport brachycephalic dogs in the cargo hold.
- If travelling during months of intense temperatures, ensure that the cargo area will accommodate those extremes and maintain a tolerable climate.
- Fit your dog's collar so that he/she cannot get caught in their carrier door.
- Affix a travel label to your carrier.
- Make sure that your dog's nails have been clipped (so they don't get hooked anywhere within the carrier or on its door).
- Give your dog at least a month of exposure to his/her travel carrier-to ensure a reasonable level of comfort.
- Do not feed your dog for 4-6 hours before the trip
- Avoid flying during busy travel times, if possible. Rushed attendants are more likely to mishandle your precious pup.
- Carry a current photograph of your dog.
- When you arrive at your destination, examine your pet immediately.

Yes, air travel with your pet can be nerve-racking, inconvenient, expensive, and sometimes even fun, but whatever the outcome of your voyage through the heavens, your furry kiddo will no doubt enjoy being included in your travels because being with you is his ultimate destination.

A Word from Charitable Funds...

As many of you know the US Kerry Blue Charitable Fund was established in 2002. Its purpose was to serve the Kerry Blue Terrier in four important areas:

- 1) Rescue Fund** – this fund supports grants used to provide Kerry Blue Terrier rescue services.
- 2) Health and Genetics Fund** - this fund makes grants in support of research in areas of health and genetics of particular importance to the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- 3) Education Fund** – the education fund supports education of all those interested in the Kerry Blue Terrier including publications, websites, and seminars.
- 4) General Fund** – donations to this fund are used to support the work of the other funds through internal grants to those funds. Undesignated gifts will initially be held in this fund.

Since Charitable Funds was established we have worked diligently to build its assets. The USKBTC undertook major support of the PNA Research being done at the University of Missouri, and contributors finally received welcome news of a test for this dreaded disease. To date we have awarded over \$20,000 in grants to support Health and Genetics, Education, and Rescue ~ all thanks to your donations.

Our past efforts have been focused on methods to identify genetic problems that plagued our breed. We have seen advances aided by monies from Charitable Funds in identifying markers for PNA (now called CMSD), Degenerative Myelopathy (DM) and von Willibrands. The tests that have arisen from the identification of these markers have given breeders new tools to eliminate or greatly reduce the impact of these genetic diseases on the breed. What we now need to look at are *curative* diseases such as cancer, which today is claiming the lives of a large number of our Kerry blues, as well as other breeds. The studies to eliminate these diseases will be found only through a joint effort of the genetics laboratories and research facilities. We must grow our financial resources substantially in order to have meaningful impact, and that means it will take many years to be in a position to have a significant impact on our core areas.

We believe the real key to long term growth will be planned giving that includes the Funds in the wills of our members. Other comparable organizations have used this method as the key to growing their assets. You can help by considering making the Funds one of the recipients of your estate. In addition, support an area of interest today. We have grown our asset base through small gifts and that will be crucial to our future.

DENTISTRY & YOUR KERRY

Dental health is a crucial component of your dog's overall health. Poor dental care allows for plaque to build up on the teeth surfaces. This plaque harbors bacteria which can then enter the bloodstream and affect major internal organs, primarily the liver, kidneys, lungs, heart and brain. Research has shown that dogs with poor oral health may have shortened life spans.

Veterinary dentistry includes the cleaning, filling, adjustment, extraction and repair of your dogs' teeth and all other aspects of your pets' oral health care. These procedures need to be performed by a licensed veterinarian or a board certified veterinary dentist.

The causes of dental problems are very similar to those of humans although dogs are less likely to get cavities than we are.

Dental issues can involve broken teeth, periodontal disease, abscesses or infected teeth, cysts or tumors in the mouth, uneven teeth and bite, broken jaw and palate defects.

Part of your dogs' yearly exam should include a thorough oral exam. However, a visit to your veterinarian should be scheduled if you notice the following: bad breath, swelling in the areas surrounding the mouth, broken or loose teeth, teeth that are discolored or covered in tartar, abnormal chewing, dropping food from the mouth when eating, drooling, bleeding from the mouth, reduced appetite or refusing to eat, and pain in or around the mouth. A change in your dog's overall behavior can also be an indication of disease of the mouth.

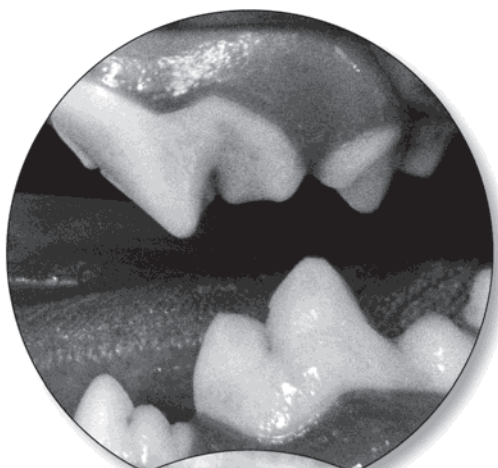
Some dogs become very irritable and may start showing aberrant or even aggressive behavior due to a painful mouth.

Three of the most commonly seen oral disease issues in dogs are periodontal disease, fractured teeth and maxillary draining tracts. I will explain these briefly in the following paragraphs.

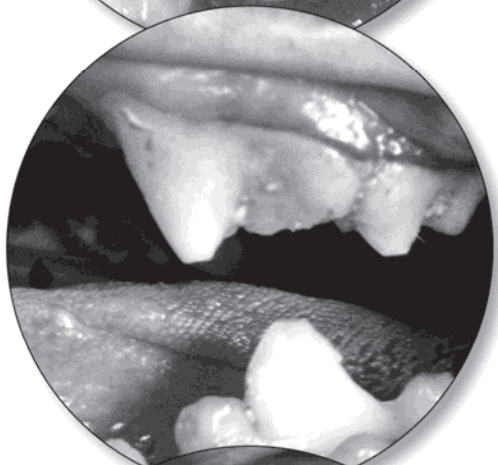
Periodontal disease is the most common dental condition in dogs. By the time your dog is three years old there will be some early evidence of this disease. If left unattended it will worsen with time and potentially affect your dogs' overall health. Once gum disease sets in it cannot be cured but will need to be controlled for the rest of your dogs' life, so early detection and treatment is essential.

Periodontal disease starts with plaque buildup, that sticky bacterial-filled film that covers your dog's teeth. This plaque hardens into tartar, a calcified hard structure that acts as a framework for more plaque and tartar to build

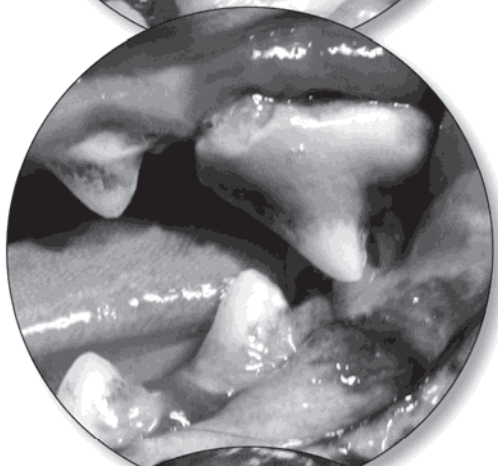




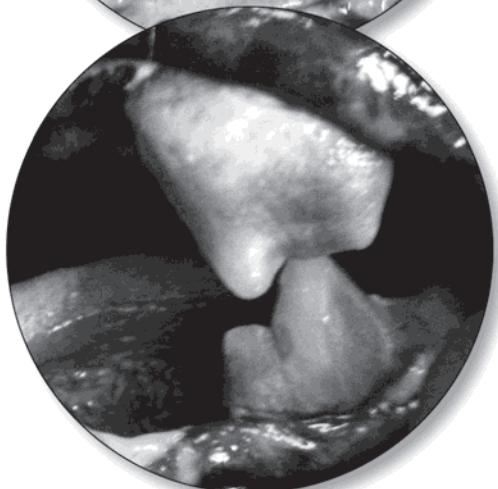
upon. This tartar above the gum line is easy to see, but 60% of the tooth structure lies below the gum line and it is more difficult to detect and remove. This plaque and tartar below the gum line will be very damaging, setting the stage for infection and damage to the jawbone and the tissues that connect the tooth to the jawbone. Addressing this involves a thorough cleaning under anesthesia, with oral radiographs to determine the severity of the disease.



A fractured tooth is also a very common problem. Approximately 25% of dogs presented at veterinary clinics have one or more fractured teeth, with 10% of those having pulp exposure. The tooth pulp is the soft tissue forming the inner structure of the tooth and containing nerves and blood vessels. Once exposed to the oral cavity, it becomes contaminated, infected and starts dying off, resulting in root abscesses and pain. Oral radiographs are needed to determine the extent of tooth and surrounding bone structure damage. Treatment options include extraction or root canal.



Maxillary draining tracts is also a common scenario presented at veterinary clinics. This is a draining lesion right underneath your dog's eye caused by an infected premolar or molar tooth. Anesthesia with a thorough oral exam and oral radiographs will be needed to identify the tooth involved and the extent of the damage. Surgical extraction of the affected tooth is often necessary to treat the infection.



The need for anesthesia is sometimes questioned by owners not only because it adds to the cost of the procedure, but also because of the concern of the risk that this may create. "By definition, a complete and comprehensive oral exam includes a complete visualization of all structures, periodontal probing, and dental x-rays...Non anesthetic dentistry is essentially a cosmetic procedure that addresses only the visible surfaces of only some of the dog's teeth." Dogs, unlike humans, will not open their mouths and stand still while the teeth are examined, probed and radiographed. Attempting to perform a thorough dental exam while the dog is fully conscious is not only limiting but can also pose a danger to the dog and to the veterinary staff. The AVMA, American Animal Association and American Veterinary Dental College do not recommend

dental cleanings without anesthesia for the reasons outlined above. Bear in mind that anesthetic protocols and agents have come a long ways in the past years and have been proved to be very safe. You should be able to discuss your concerns with your veterinarian.

Dental health care starts at home. Between your yearly visit to the veterinarian it is important that routine brushing of the dog's teeth is done. Daily brushing is best, but not always possible and brushing several times a week may be sufficient. Follow these tips on brushing your dog's teeth.

1. Do not use a children's toothbrush as the bristles may be too hard. The ideal dog toothbrush will be one with a long angled handle and extra soft bristles.
2. The best toothpastes are those made for animals. Human toothpastes are not made for ingestion and thus can be irritating/ toxic to dogs. Try to avoid toothpastes with baking soda, detergents and salts found in human toothpastes. The best toothpastes contain

enzymes that continue to break down bacteria and plaque well after the brushing action is over. Fluoride may be incorporated to help control bacteria. When brushing your dog's teeth focus on the outside surfaces, being methodical and thorough. The tongue has a brushing action on the inside surface and tends to accumulate less tartar than the outside ones.

In addition, nutrition plays an important role in your dog's dental health. Dental diets and chews can be very effective. Dental diets work either by "brushing" the crowns of the teeth, or by coating a tartar retardant agent on the surface of the teeth. There are many products on the market promoting dental care but not all are effective. Ask your veterinarian what best suits your dog's needs.

Dental oral care is important in maintaining your dog's overall health. By providing frequent brushings at home and having your dog's teeth checked yearly by your veterinarian you can add years to your animal's life.

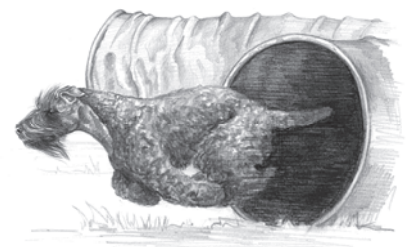

AKC Museum of the Dog

Interview with Stephen George, Director

The AKC Museum of the Dog is located on a beautiful site at 1721 So. Mason Rd, St Louis, MO. in the historical Jarville House, built in 1853. In addition to housing a wonderful collection of paintings, prints and everything canine, the site is open to parties, weddings and to many local dog club events.

Tell us about your background, Stephen.

My background is not like that of most museum directors, but that of a vice president and senior project or program manager in the large and complex engineering and science sector across North America. I've also served on several non-profit boards, served as president of one university's college of engineering board, and served as an ex-officio member on four other university nonprofit boards. It all gave me a great background in knowledge of and management of a non-profit operation, and one in transition that could use a new view.

The museum originally started at the AKC headquarters in New York City in 1982. By 1987 the museum moved to the Jarvil House located in St Louis, MO. What year did the museum do extensive renovations and what was done to expand the facilities?

The museum moved into the newest wing in the early 90's. Minor renovations continue on a routine basis.

You came to the museum in 2012 and since that time I've noticed major changes with new and innovative programs. What new programs have been added under your leadership?

First of all the credit for the new programs is due to staff, not me. Their knowledge, experience,

contributions to the effort and dedication to the cause are what makes this museum what it is. They are responsible for developing ideas, tweaking mine, putting programs into place and managing them. I have encouraged them and lead the operation, but they are the heartbeat.

New programs include a winter lecture series, art classes for children and for adults, a museum book club, guest exhibitors, up and coming artist weekends, an enhanced Guest Dog of the Week Program, a Paws for Reading Program in 2014 and several others.

The museum seems to be very active in the St., Louis community. What do you do to foster this?

I am active in the local Chamber of Commerce, the local community public arts council, the St. Louis Convention and Visitor's Commission, and the St. Louis Attractions Association. I have been interviewed multiple times on TV, radio, for newspapers and magazines, and I attend local luncheons and breakfasts as a guest speaker. I also attend local media arts events. But again, it is not just me. This is a team effort here. Staff members and volunteers are encouraged to attend events

at Purina Farms, take classes at the local community college, attend openings at museums in the area, participate in dog shows, and spend time just reaching out. This has resulted in our museum coordinator being asked to be a guest lecturer, and one of our part time staff to be requested to write magazine articles.

How much of the museum is supported by the American Kennel Club and how much is supported by individual donations?

Although the AKC supported the museum with a significant gift for several years, it has not supported us financially since 2012.

All museums use volunteers. What do your volunteers do? How many do you have? Do you have a volunteer coordinator?

Yes, we do have volunteers, probably 20 that are very active. They attend events and cover our booth at those, they act as volunteer docents, they help with the Guest Dog program, they cover the admissions desk at times, and just do whatever we need done, if asked.

How often do you change your special exhibitions and who determines what these will be?

Special exhibits are changed on a non-specific schedule, but more often under my tenure than ever before. I like to have a reason for patrons to come back, and that is quite a good way. Most special exhibits are up not more than a few months. The decision on special exhibits is made by me, but the ideas are a group effort. Staff members come to me with ideas and then we hash out the logistics, costs, time and timing. Some ideas don't make it past the first discussion. The exhibits' ideas that do make the cut are then made a reality by our Museum Coordinator and our Special Events Coordinator.

You have a good newsletter, Sirius. How often does it come out?

Sirius has been in limbo for more than a year as we decided how to change it, improve it and make it more informational. I am happy to say the next issue will likely be out in October. Our plan is to issue it two to three times per year.

AKC Museum Interview with Stephen George

The library is a newer addition to the museum. I recall that the room is rather small. Do you have any plans to expand the size? Is there any preference to the types of books that are donated?

The library is actually not a new addition. It is housed in the library of Jarville House and consists primarily of books of historic importance or value regarding dogs. It has been there for years, and consists of books donated, not purchased. Your thought on our library being new is just ahead of the curve a bit though, as we are in the process of raising funds to revamp one of our rooms off the main lobby. That room will function as a library, reading room, boardroom and general business meeting room for anyone local who may wish to rent it.

Thank you for spending your time with us. Stephen. Blueprints urges all of our readers who are in the St. Louis area, or at the Purina Event Center to add the AKC Museum of the Dog to their list of things to do. It's a very special and charming place where the dog is celebrated in all of its glory.

De-Skunking

Loss of habitat is forcing more and more wildlife into populated areas, so even if you are a city dweller, your dog may encounter a skunk. There are several products on the market made specifically for removing skunk spray. Two such products are "Nature's Miracle Skunk Odor Remover" by Nature's Miracle, and "Skunk Off" by Thornwell Corporation.

Some suggestions for bathing a dog who has skunk odor:

Before handling your dog, you may want to change your clothes. Skunk spray is very difficult to remove from clothing. Cover the dog's bed with something to protect it. Leaving the dog outdoors for a while will greatly reduce the odor.

Determine where the spray hit the dog. Depending on your dog's hair type, you may be able to trim away or comb out some of the affected hair.

When you're ready to wash the dog, only clean the sprayed area. Skunk spray is oily and can easily be spread all over the dog. Since you will likely have to repeat the procedure, save an all-over bath until the second or third washing.

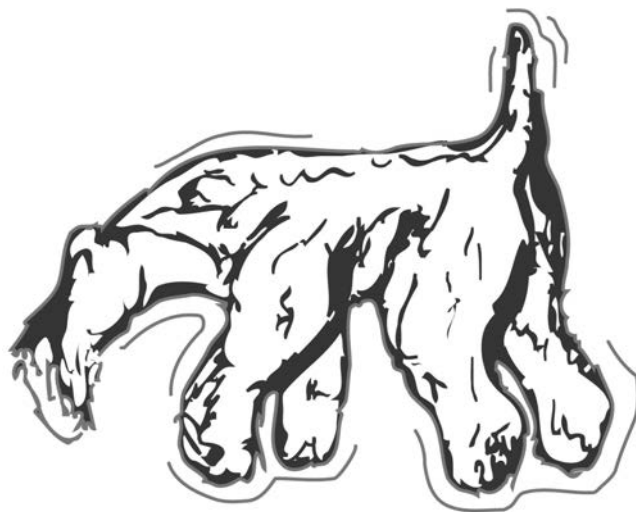
Editor's Note:

In a recent article (December 2003) of "Your Dog" newsletter published by Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine, they suggested a safe home treatment for de-skunking your dog.

Wash the dog with the following mixture:

One-fourth of a cup of baking soda
One teaspoon of liquid soap
One quart of hydrogen peroxide

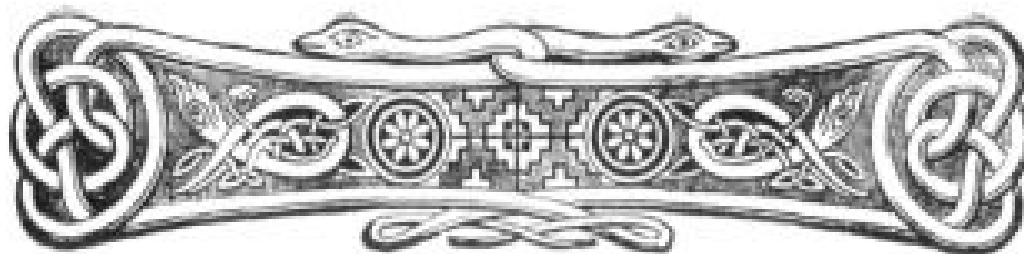

Categories of Awards:

1. Category 1 -Service Dog:

Service or assistance dogs are trained to assist individuals with meeting special needs on a daily basis; these needs can be physical, psychological and/or emotional; examples include hearing, sight service dogs and alert response dogs who alert their human companions to seizures and other medical emergencies;

2. Category 2 -Therapy Dog:

Therapy dogs are trained to provide care and comfort to patients and residents in medical care facilities, retirement communities and shelters; Examples include retirement communities; senior centers; veterans homes, military hospitals; healthcare facilities, hospitals, hospice and medical care facilities; children's hospitals, rehabilitation centers such as shelters for homeless, battered women and children; military and veterans hospitals and recovery centers for wounded soldiers.

3. Category 3 -Educational Service/Therapy Dog :

Educational Service Dogs or therapy dogs work with children in public and private schools in academic and special needs areas; Programs can include but are not limited to the Bite Avoidance programs in schools and organizations such as The Boys and Girls Clubs; Canine-Assisted Reading Programs in Schools and Libraries; Safety School Crossing Program; Programs include Kerries teaching children how to interact with dogs and build a positive relationship with dogs;

4. Category 4 -Exemplary Companion Dog /Act of Exemplary Performance:

The Exemplary Companion Dog is the Kerry who has performed a one time event of an exemplary act, contributed to others or a Kerry who has exhibited companionship to an individual under exemplary circumstances (Example: saving family members from a fire in the home or acted as a companion to a person who is terminally ill;) Other examples of exemplary performance include Kerries who serve in search and rescue, or work with military, firefighters and police in security and rescue.

Award Criteria:

1. The dog must be a purebred Kerry Blue Terrier;
2. The dog must be nominated by a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition; the owner(s) of the dog does not need to be a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition;

Award:

- Each qualified recipient who contributes in one area receives a Level I Certificate and Medallion; Contributions in two areas received a Level II Certificate and Medallion and those who contribute in three areas receive a Level III Certificate and Medallion.

Recognition:

- Each recipient will be recognized in Blueprints; on the USKBTC website, and at their local specialty of choice, if desired and requested.
