The first is a new program that recognizes those Kerry Blue Terriers among us that bring good to people. The award program is called "Kerry It Forward" and is setup to honor Service Kerries, Therapy Kerries, Exemplary Companion Kerries, Search and Rescue Kerries, Law Enforcement Kerries and any other Kerries that provide service to other people. Jann Lane and June Hulit did all the research and development on this new program and you will find more detailed information elsewhere in this issue of Blueprints. Thanks to all who worked very hard on this project.

Another project that the board has been working on is a Policy and Procedures Manual. For years as a club we have had committees that worked with rules and guidelines, that for the most part have never been written down in a standardized system. Now thanks to the US Board Members we have been "revisiting" many of our standing committees. After these committee's rules and guidelines have been reviewed they are sent to Bob Nazak who has agreed to put them into a standardized form to go into a Policy and Procedures book. This should make the daily operation of the club much easier for everyone.

One of the standing committees the board has been reviewing is the Futurity. After much discussion and research the Governors are considering some significant changes to the Futurity. Some of these changes will hopefully be incorporated this year, so watch the USKBTC web site for details and updates. Any changes will be announced by May 1, 2010, so again check the web site. If you have any Futurity questions please give me a call and I will do all I can to help you.

For years the USKBTC has been trying to improve the ring conditions at Hatboro. Last year the Grange did some improvements to the area we usually exhibit in and these upgrades made conditions much better. The lighting in that area has always been an issue and after several failed attempts to improve this problem, Larry Brown helped the USKBTC negotiate with the Grange an improvement to the lighting system that the board felt the club could afford. The cost of the improvements to the lighting was shared by the Grange, the Philadelphia Kerry Blue Terrier Club and the USKBTC. A special thank you to Larry Brown and the Philadelphia Club for helping get these improvements completed.

Hope you have had a great year so far and that we will see you at some of the shows. There are some great specialties in the upcoming months. Look for all the details in this issue of Blueprints and on the USKBTC website. Have a great spring and summer!

2009 AKC Agility Invitational

The AKC Agility Invitational held in Long Beach December 12 & 13 in conjunction with the Eukanuba National Championship Show proved to be the best showing for the Kerries in the events four year history. This was our second year to have a full entry of 5 dogs and the first time a Kerry has gone to the finals!

The caliber of our entry continues to rise. Dogs and handlers are reaping the rewards of better training methods and experience. The difference between the first Invitational held in 2006 and this year is night and day. This event is truly becoming what it was intended to be, a showcase for all the breeds involved in agility. There were at least three members of the World Team running their dogs.

The five dogs & handlers qualifying in the Top 5 for this event listed from 1 to 5 are:

The real test of a team is the year's work spent making it to the top.

With the open entry for the Eukanuba National Championship, agility competition was moved to tents in the parking lot. The running surface for the first time was sod instead of the rubber matting. It was a surface which seemed to work well for most of the teams. Rain proved to be quite a challenge both inside the tents and out. Fortunately by Saturday afternoon 2 X 4"s and plywood were being used to raise our crates above the water. Sunday's sunshine was a welcome relief!

The courses for the first two Rounds had their challenges but they flowed nicely for the dogs. Day 2 brought more difficult challenges with the Round 3 Jumpers course and the most difficult of the four the Hybrid Round 4 course. Called a Hybrid because it uses only two of the contact obstacles. For this course an A-frame and a Teeter Totter were used. It contained a little "Bermuda Triangle" at the back of the course which eliminated a large number of the remaining teams.

Our entry was divided between the 16" and 20" classes with Bailey and Betty Richardson's Riley in 20" and Tide, Birdie and Maggie Hall's Riley in 16".

Our results after four rounds of competition:

Maggie Hall and Birdie with four clean rounds to make the finals in 11th place and win the Top Scoring Kerry Medallion. This team ran another clean round in the finals to place 7th out of 91 dogs in 16".

Tracey Fulmer and Bailey had 2 clean rounds for a total score of 390, placing 43 out of 87 in 20"

Betty Richardson and Riley had 3 clean rounds for a score of 385, placing 45 out of 87 in 20"

Maggie Hall and Riley had 1 clean round for a score of 385, placing 51 out of 91 in 16"

Eve Fishell and Tide had 3 clean rounds for a score of 363, placing 61 out of 91 in 16"

A great showing for all these teams and especially to Birdie, the first Kerry to make the Finals at this event. Congratulations to all the teams on a job well done!

If you have a dog that may have a bit of unknown ancestry, or some non-Kerry ancestry, he or she can still be registered through the AKC, and participate in AKC activities and programs. Your dog will be able to participate through the new program called the "Canine Partners Program" specifically designed for mixed breed dogs. Through AKC registration, all dogs will receive a voice.

By registering your dogs with the AKC, you are also supporting the AKC Canine Health Foundation, the canine research foundation responsible for mapping the canine genome; you and your dogs are also supporting search and rescue teams trained to assist in natural and disasters; you will also be supporting educational programs for children.

Just as we, as citizens, are provided a voice through our vote/registration--your dog is provided a voice through AKC registration. Give your dog a vote today.

In Recognition of Past and Present Kerry Blue Terriers' Canine-Humanitarian Contribution to Society and to the Individual By Jann Lane, Charitable Funds

To know one, is to love one. To love one, is to know that the Kerry Blue Terrier is a special breed that contributes to our lives in many ways. Those Kerries who have chosen to "Kerry It Forward" and give back to society, will be recognized by the USKBTC Charitable Funds through the "Kerry It Forward" Award beginning fall of 2010.

The USKBTC currently honors and recognizes the Kerry Blue Terriers' structure or 'form' through conformation competition at our national specialty and chapter club specialties each year.

We also recognize the Kerry's work or 'function' through performance events such as herding, agility, tracking, obedience, and rally, through events held nationally and regionally. Kerries have demonstrated their proficiency in all of these performance arenas.

Beginning in 2010, the USKBTC Charitable Funds will recognize the Kerry Blue Terrier's third dimension, its heart, and our breed's contributions through the establishment of the "Kerry It Forward" Awards.

Kerries involved in public service are most often the unsung heroes of our Kerry community. You may be familiar with their service in nursing homes, assisted living centers, and hospitals. However, Kerries are also teachers. Kerries go to schools, and can be found helping children learn to read, through canine-assisted reading programs, building self- confidence. As we honor the recipients of this award, you will also read about Kerries who have helped children safely cross the street on their way to school. Some Kerries are involved in other canine education programs, such as the Bite Prevention programs. Other Kerries have chosen a special mission and have intervened to save human lives.

As we honor these special Kerries in the years ahead, you will read about them, their journeys and how each has contributed to Society and to the Individual. We look forward to honoring them as much as you will enjoy reading about them. Thank you, to all Therapy and Service Kerries, past and present, for your service to our canine community.

If you are aware of a Kerry who meets the criteria listed below, and you are a USKBTC member, please consider nominating him or her. These special Kerries often do not seek recognition and owners may need your encouragement. This is our way of thanking them for their contributions. If you have questions, please feel free to contact me at the email listed (drlane@mackenziesteel.com) or any Charitable Funds board member for more information.

This award recognizes the canine-humanitarian contribution to society and the individual through the following award categories:

1. Category 1 Service Dog:

Service or assistance dogs are trained to assist individuals with meeting special needs on a daily basis; these needs can be physical, psychological and/or emotional; examples include hearing, sight service dogs and alert response dogs who alert their human companions to seizures and other medical emergencies;

2. Category 2 Therapy Dog:

Therapy dogs are trained to provide care and comfort to patients and residents in medical care facilities, retirement communities and shelters; Examples include retirement communities; senior centers; veterans homes, military hospitals; healthcare facilities, hospitals, hospite and medical care facilities; children's hospitals, rehabilitation centers such as shelters for homeless, battered women and children; military and veterans hospitals and recovery centers;

3. Category 3 Educational Service Dog (Therapy Dog):

Educational Service Dog works with children in public and private schools in academic and special needs areas; Programs can include but are not limited to the Bite Avoidance programs in schools and organizations such as The Boys and Girls Clubs; Canine-Assisted Reading Programs; Safety School Crossing Program; Programs include Kerries teaching children how to interact with dogs and build a positive relationship with dogs;

4. Category 4 Exemplary Companion Dog /Act of Exemplary Performance:

The Exemplary Companion Dog is the Kerry who has performed a one time event of an exemplary act, contributed to others or a Kerry who has exhibited companionship to an individual under exemplary circumstances (Example: saving family members from a fire in the home or acted as a companion to a person who is terminally ill;) Other examples of exemplary performance include Kerries who serve in search and rescue, or work with firefighters and police in security and rescue.

5. Category 5 KIF In Memoriam:

A special category for those Kerries who would have qualified in one of the categories above but have passed away; For the first year of the award, we will honor those special Kerry Blue Terriers who are no longer with us, but contributed to Society or to the Individual in the past, in special ways. These dogs and their contributions are not to be forgotten.

Award Criteria:

- 1. The dog must be a purebred Kerry Blue Terrier;
- 2. The dog must be nominated by a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition; the owner(s) of the dog does not need to be a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition;
- For the first two years of the award, (2010-2012) AKC and other certification registry requirements for the applicant are waived; after which a minimum of AKC-PAL registration will be required; additional requirements for certification may be added per award category, as necessary.

Award:

- Each qualified recipient who contributes in one area receives a Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in two areas receives a Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in three areas or more receives a Certificate and Medallion

Recognition:

Each recipient will be recognized in Blueprints; on the USKBTC website, at Montgomery and their local specialty, if applicable.

1. Category 1 Service Dog:

Service or assistance dogs are trained to assist individuals with meeting special needs on a daily basis; these needs can be physical, psychological and/or emotional; examples include hearing, sight service dogs and alert response dogs who alert their human companions to seizures and other medical emergencies;

2. Category 2 Therapy Dog:

Therapy dogs are trained to provide care and comfort to patients and residents in medical care facilities, retirement communities and shelters; Examples include retirement communities; senior centers; veterans homes, military hospitals; healthcare facilities, hospitals, hospice and medical care facilities; children's hospitals, rehabilitation centers such as shelters for homeless, battered women and children; military and veterans hospitals and recovery centers for wounded soldiers.

3. Category 3 Educational Service/Therapy Dog:

Educational Service Dogs or therapy dogs work with children in public and private schools in academic and special needs areas; Programs can include but are not limited to the Bite Avoidance programs in schools and organizations such as The Boys and Girls Clubs; Canine-Assisted Reading Programs in Schools and Libraries; Safety School Crossing Program; Programs include Kerries teaching children how to interact with dogs and build a positive relationship with dogs;

4. Category 4 Exemplary Companion Dog /Act of Exemplary Performance:

The Exemplary Companion Dog is the Kerry who has performed a one time event of an exemplary act, contributed to others or a Kerry who has exhibited companionship to an individual under exemplary circumstances (Example: saving family members from a fire in the home or acted as a companion to a person who is terminally ill;) Other examples of exemplary performance include Kerries who serve in search and rescue, or work with military, firefighters and police in security and rescue.

5. Category 5 KIF In Memoriam:

A special category for those Kerries who would have qualified in one of the categories above but have passed away; For the first year of the award, we will honor those special Kerry Blue Terriers who are no longer with us, but contributed to Society or to the Individual in the past, in special ways. You and your contributions are not forgotten.

Award Criteria:

- The dog must be a purebred Kerry Blue Terrier;
- The dog must be nominated by a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition; the owner(s) of the dog does not need to be a member of the USKBTC to receive the award/recognition;
- For the first two years of the award, (2010-2012) AKC and other certification registry
 requirements for the applicant are waived; after which a minimum of AKC-PAL
 registration will be required; additional requirements for certification may be added per
 award category, as necessary.

Award:

- Each qualified recipient who contributes in one area receives a Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in two areas receives a Certificate and Medallion;
- Each qualified recipient who contributes in three areas or more receives a Certificate and Medallion

Recognition:

Each recipient will be recognized in Blueprints; on the USKBTC website, at Montgomery and their local specialty, if applicable.


F. Old Business

G. New Business



USKBTC 2009 Financial Report

Just as 2009 was a difficult year for most of us that was also true of the United States Kerry Blue Terrier Club, Inc. We ended the year with an operating loss. This loss was primarily due to a significant reduction in donations to the trophy fund for Montgomery County and action is being taken to assure trophy expense is more in line with donations. In addition, through the generosity of our members we raised \$2173.75 for Charitable Funds which will be transferred to Charitable Funds this fiscal year which will reduce our cash balances. The 2009 report includes the Futurity payout for 2008 of approximately \$1208.95 as well as the settlement for the Kimberton Terrier Trials in 2008 of \$750.00. The Governors Expense of \$163.50 was the cost of the meeting room at the annual Board meeting the Montgomery County weekend. In 2009 the Futurity did not achieve a positive cash flow and the Governors will be announcing soon how the payout will be handled. The balance in our cash accounts at the end of 2009 was \$33,805.07 versus \$36,173.40. This is a reasonable balance for a Parent Club of our size.

OFA UPDATE!

As some of you have noticed, recent issues of Blue-Prints have contained few or no OFA results. This is not because we haven't been testing our dogs. Here is the reason why:

OFA maintains two health databases, a closed one (C), where **only normal** results are available to the public, and an open one (O), where both normal and abnormal results are published. Both the C and O lists are sent to the USKBTC. Through a misunderstanding, it was believed that only the results in the open database could be published in BP. This has now been clarified; clearances from both the C and O databases for 2009 that have not been published as well as all new lists we receive will appear in the next and future issues of BluePrints. The next issue will also include some OFA application forms showing which areas to initial or sign, depending on whether you want your dog's test results included in the open or closed databases.

CHIC UPDATE

CHIC participation is up to 130 breeds, and over 57,000 dogs have received their CHIC numbers, over 2,000 already in 2010!

Champions of Health

Recently, I've had several inquiries from clubs participating in CHIC about the Annual CHIC/Parent Club Champion of Health Award. Since so many breeds have joined CHIC since we announced the program back in 2006, it seemed like the timing was appropriate make sure all clubs participating in CHIC were aware of this program. The annual CHIC/Parent Club Champion of Health Award is intended to recognize a dog that has had significant accomplishments in the ring, in the field, in performance events, as a producer, or as a working dog, AND has the full complement of health testing appropriate for its breed. The award consists of an engraved silver medallion, and a \$100 donation to the AKC Canine Health Foundation breed specific donor advised fund in the name of the honored dog. Ideally, the award would be announced and given at the club's annual awards banquet.

To participate, clubs should nominate from one to three dogs for the annual award, and present their nominations to the OFA for final selection. The club may determine its own method for selecting the nominations, whether by committee, individual submissions, or club vote. Each nomination should include a brief write-up of the dog's accomplishments as well as a record of its health certifications. Regardless of the club's selection process, it should be remembered that this is not a popularity contest and that health contributions remain the number one criteria in the selection process. The nominations must be presented to the OFA a minimum of six weeks prior to the specialty event, in order to allow time for engraving, etc. The OFA reserves the right to withhold the award based on a lack of suitable nominees.

Online Health Surveys

If your club is in need of an updated health survey, the OFA might be your ideal resource to help in the process. The OFA is currently hosting over 20 online breed specific surveys. The surveys are an online tool, provide real time results, are tailored to individual club needs and requirements, and best of all, are provided as a service to clubs at no charge. If interested, please visit the OFA website at **www.offa.org**. The surveys are accessible from the homepage. Feel free to take any of the surveys to get a feel for what can be provided. As long as you don't hit the final submit button, you won't skew any results.



CHIC DNA Repository

The CHIC DNA Repository recently reached a significant milestone when we cataloged our 10,000th sample. The CHIC DNA Repository, jointly sponsored by the

OFA and the AKC Canine Health Foundation, collects and stores canine DNA samples along with corresponding pedigree and phenotypic health information to facilitate future canine health research initiatives. Leading institutions such as the Broad Institute at MIT/Harvard, UC-Davis, the University of Missouri, Clemson University, and others have already benefited from samples received from the CHIC DNA bank. The existing large sample base is in large part the result of DNA collection clinics sponsored by individual breed parent clubs in conjunction with their national specialties. Please contact us as chic@offa.org if your club is interested in holding a collection clinic.

Parent Club Conference

Once again this fall, the AKC will be hosting a Parent Club Conference. Hopefully, each of your clubs has signed up to participate and send a representative. One of the programs will be a presentation on all the various services, programs, and ideas available to parent clubs to help promote health. These include basic CHIC participation, the online survey tool, the Champion of Health Award, DNA collection clinics, health clinics, and several unique parent club ideas. As an example, the Dalmatian Club of America Foundation provides an additional financial award if the sire and dam of the Futurity winner have received CHIC numbers. If your club has implemented anything unique that you would like to share with the conference attendees, please let me know, and we'll get the ideas included in the materials that will accompany the presentation.



- 1. A notice of your application will be published in the next Quarterly issue of the official Club publication, BLUEPRINTS.
- 2. Thirty (30) days after publication in BLUEPRINTS, your application and any member's comments will be submitted to the Board of Governors for consideration.
- 3. You will be promptly notified, in writing, of the Board's action.
- 4. You will be provided with a copy of the approved Constitution and Bylaws.

This Membership process can take up to six (6) months or more, due to the Quarterly publication of BLUEPRINTS, please be patient. Note that your check may be cashed prior to your being elected to membership. This does not automatically elect you to membership. If for any reason, you are not elected to membership; your application fee will be refunded.

THE UNITED STATES KERRY BLUE TERRIER CLUB CODE OF ETHICS

This document defines the ethical standards to which we ascribe as a condition of membership in the United Stated Kerry Blue Terrier Club (USKBTC). Membership is a privilege conferred by the Board of Governors, acting for the Membership, upon those individuals who meet the high standards set forth in the Club Constitution and Bylaws and this Code. As members, we are individually charged with complying with this code and demanding similar compliance of all other members. We must hold the interest of the Kerry Blue Terrier superior to our own in exercising the responsibilities that accompany the privileges of membership.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A MEMBER

- Members of the USKBTC, as Stewards to the breed, have the obligation to protect and serve the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier at all times. A member's every action should reflect credit on themselves, the USKBTC and, above all, the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- The approved standard for the breed is the fundamental imperative guiding our actions. Members have the obligation to protect and serve these standards as a condition of membership.
- Members must be familiar with and comply with the rules of the American Kennel Club (AKC); the Constitution and By-laws of the USKBTC; and (as appropriate) the rules established by any member club of the USKBTC.
- Members will observe the highest standards of conduct and sportsmanship at all times. Whether as a breeder, exhibitor, or spectator, they shall conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the Kerry Blue Terrier, dogs in general, and the sport of showing dogs.

Members shall maintain the highest standards of health and sanitation for their own Kerry Blue Terriers, as well as for any other animals in their possession or entrusted to their care. They shall demand the same high standards of others, members and non-members alike.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BREEDER

A Breeder shall:

- Be guided at all times by the approved standard for the Kerry Blue Terrier and shall consider breeding only those specimens that conform to the standard.
- When contemplating breeding a litter or providing the services of a stud dog, strive toward maintaining breed type and producing dogs of exceptional quality, temperament, and condition. Breeding or supporting breeding to a lesser standard is not acceptable.
- Use for breeding only those dogs that are healthy and free from serious congenital and hereditary defects. Refrain from further use, any bitch or stud dog that has developed such a health problem or produced any serious inherited defects detrimental to the offspring and the overall well being of the breed.
- Not use a bitch for breeding prior to reaching eighteen (18) months of age (preferably 24 months) or older than eight (8) years of age. A bitch should not be bred more than two (2) out of three (3) consecutive heat cycles, nor produce more than five (5) litters in her lifetime. Recognizing the variations in heat cycles and sizes of litters, valid exceptions may exist, however it is incumbent on the breeder to exercise good judgment in exercising such exceptions.
- Not sell puppies to pet shops either outright or on consignment; supply puppies for auctions, raffles, or other such activities; refrain from selling to persons whose intention (either known or suspected) is to resell or use the puppy in a breeding program not complying with this code of ethics. The breeder shall ensure that the prospective buyer is prepared to provide the same degree of care required of members of the USKBTC. The Code of Ethics should be provided and discussed with potential buyers as part of a thorough screening process. All buyers should be encouraged to become members of the USKBTC and member clubs.
- Promptly apply for AKC registration of the litter. Puppies should not be sold prior to reaching ten (10) weeks of age (preferably 12 weeks). The sale of every dog shall include a signed registration or registration application (Blue Slip), and a four-generation pedigree. Any exceptions to these requirements, or valid restrictions or limitations imposed as conditions to the sale (e.g., no breeding) must be agreed to in writing by both parties at the time of sale. It is strongly recommended that a written agreement accompany all sales. Buyers should be provided with assistance and support in the setting of ears and in learning proper grooming. If the buyer is not located in the same area, the breeder should make arrangements with another USKBTC member in that area to assist the new owner.
- Provide with each sale, a record of dated and types of immunization given, immunizations required, and veterinary health records. Instructions should be provided, preferably in writing, on diseases and hereditary factors related to the breed, proper medical care, feeding, and grooming. Providing a copy of the current USKBTC Handbook represents a means of conveying this type of information, and is a sound investment on the part of the breeder. No puppy should be sold without either temporary or permanent protection against distemperhepatitis and parvo. Puppies should have a veterinary examination, and worming if required, before sale.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of stock, matings, pedigrees, show records, and transfers. Breeders are responsible for conducting research on their pedigrees to ensure correct ancestry, accurate spelling of names and correct registration numbers. Breeders should be familiar with and comply with all record keeping requirements required by the AKC. Litter registration applications must be correct and promptly requested. Individual puppy registration should be completed in a timely manner.
- Shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or other misrepresentations with respect to their own breeding. They shall not malign others by making false or misleading statements regarding another member's dogs, breeding practices, or person. Advertising should not be worded to attract undesirable buyers nor encourage raising dogs for profit.
- Consider the growing problems related to excess dogs ending up in animal shelters and should exercise sound judgment and prudent restraint in their breeding programs. Litters should be limited to numbers that are consistent with achieving a sound breeding program and the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- Be prepared to assume lifetime responsibility for any litter produced.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN EXHIBITOR OR HANDLER

- Act professionally at all times in caring for and exhibiting any dog in your charge.
- Do not engage in any questionable contact with judges prior to exhibiting under them.
- Comply with AKC Rules and Regulations for Dog Shows, Obedience Trials, Field Trials, and The Guidelines for Dog Show Judges.
- Exhibit or handle only those dogs that conform as closely as possible to the approved standard.
- Do not indulge in the practice of making "kennel majors", or exhibiting filler dogs that they know themselves to be unworthy of championships, for the purpose of finishing dogs. Such practices lessen the meaning and value of a championship and do not serve the breed.

IV. ENFORCEMENT

- The USKBTC expects adherence to this Code of Ethics and blatant disregard of these standards will not be condoned. Violations of the standards are not in the best interests of the Club or the breed. Such behavior can serve as a cause of imposing discipline or terminating membership if charges are brought before the Board of Governors in accordance with the procedures as defined in Article VI (Discipline) of the USKBTC Constitution and Bylaws.
- Article VI addresses the specific procedures for proffering charges; the hearing process; and the rights of the parties involved. Each member is expected to be fully familiar with this very important provision of the By-laws.
