

Soon we will have names for each polar vortex that dips into the U.S. from Canada. I have to say I am sorry to all of our Canada members for implying that I blame it on Canada. I do not. We can concentrate on the snow amounts that have dropped from the Rockies to the tip of Maine. Here in Jersey we are

close to our record yearly snow fall of 59 inches. Here is where perspective comes in. The people in and around Buffalo will laugh at that number. As of this writing, they have had 275 inches of snow fall. California I am sure would love to have the water from that snow when it thaws. That will help with the drought.

The reason I say it has been a great start to 2014 is because of everything the club and the Board have accomplished since the beginning of the year. By now all of you have had the opportunity to visit our new website. It was rolled out in January by Carol and Bill Kearney after an extensive development and quality assurance period. What a great new look and feel. We are trying to attract new people who do not know the Kerry and whose interest will be captured by the website. We have had many members send in their pictures which will be used on the website's scrolling feature. Carol and Bill tested the site on many versions of software and have tested the site on I-Phone's and Androids. I am very happy to say that there have been very few issues with the site. All of us should congratulate Carol and Bill when we get the chance on a job well done.

The Board has not been idle as well. The club has voted and agreed to hold a concurrent specialty on the Friday date at Hatboro. This will give all exhibitors the opportunity for another major win (we are hoping for a 4 or 5 point win) without having to move to another location. We are also hoping the classes will start early (1:00 or 1:30) so that people will still be able to get to the annual dinner early enough. We believe this will work great for everyone. I will make one note on the dinner. My wife, Kathy, will be responsible for the reservations again this year. Last year there was a little mix up early in the year and the Board does not want to change something that worked so Kathy has agreed to carry on. There were no gifts or arm twisting required.

The Board has also voted on moving our National Sweeps from Hatboro back to Montgomery KC on Sunday. Many of you will remember that this is where it started and the Board felt that the National Sweeps should be held with the National Specialty. Besides the move of the sweeps to Montgomery KC site, the National Futurity/Maturity is moving to the same site on the Saturday before the National Specialty. New site has also brought us new chairpersons. Lisa Kunze and Lucy Noe have agreed to jointly chair the Futurity/Maturity. I am sure they could use help, please pick up the phone and volunteer. We are hoping the new site encourages exhibitors to enter the Futurity/Maturity. Part of the issue with the Futurity was that after the judging at Hatboro on the Saturday, everyone had to pack up and go to Montgomery to set up for the next day. Now, we will be set up and no worry about how long the Futurity/Maturity judging is taking. This same weekend the Board voted and agreed to "host" on September 30 the Montgomery All-Terrier Agility Cluster at a new location. The event will be indoors at "In The Net" in Palmyra, PA on Monday 29 Sep 2014 through Thursday 2 Oct 2014. The club agreed to host one of the days. We have to thank Joy Ellwanger who is Trial Chair for the USKBTC as well as Patti Campbell who has volunteered. We are looking for additional volunteers to help Joy and Patti. Don't be shy. Give them a call.

Finally, the Judge's selection committee – Nick Fletcher, Priscilla Schwenk, Martha Nazak and Eva Hansen (non-Board member) have been busy getting judges for all the events. We are getting ahead of ourselves finally as we should be in selecting judges. We have National Specialty judges, Concurrent Specialty judges and Sweeps judges for the next several years. The Board will be voting on Futurity judges as well.

Now for one of the challenges we must address in 2014. Rose Marie Mais and Denise Benincase can no longer do the Legislative follow-up for the USKBTC. They did a great job over the years and their knowledge and actions will be missed. There is a great deal of Legislative information available. The AKC newsletters – Taking Command and In Session come to mind. The USKBTC usually appoints someone the Legislative liaison to the AKC. If we think this position is necessary, I would like someone to step forward and volunteer.

We have been busy and there will be more to come. We are working on possibly offering a USKBTC application that you can down load. The handbook is being worked on by Melanie Feldges and her committee. Carol Kearney will be adding for sale in the USKBTC store many of the old Futurity prints. These are prints that any Kerry owner or collector would love to own. This is a year of change and excitement. I hope you all feel the buzz and join us any way you can. Volunteer or come out to an event near you. Give a membership to all new Kerry owners. Check out this year's events on the website. There is something for everyone. Here's to an exciting 2014!

- Meeting was called to order by John Garahan, and all were thanked for attending.
- Board Members present: John Garahan, Carl Ashby, Stephanie Clark, Diane Lee, Richard Basler, Janie MacBryde, Linda Pheasant, Gerry Yeager, Mary McGreevy, Martha Nazak, Priscilla Schwenk, Nick Fletcher, Bill Kearney. Associate Governor present: Heidi Cregor. USKBTC member present: Julee Manahan.
- Motion was made by John Garahan, seconded and passed to change the order of business. New Board members were introduced; all were approved and sworn into office. Name tags will be ordered for new Board members.

New Slate of Officers for 2014 was presented:

President: John Garahan

Vice President: Stephanie Clark

Recording Secretary:

Corresponding Secretary: Bill Kearney

Treasurer: Carl Ashby AKC Delegate: Carl Ashby

New Board of Governors: Richard Basler, Stephanie Clark, Nick Fletcher, Linda Pheasant, Gerry Yeager

- Health & Genetics Committee: Former Governor, Scott Kellogg, indicated a desire to remain active with this committee. Two other members were discussed as candidates to serve on this committee: Nadine Vukovich and Natalia Samaj-Kunze, both of whom are also veterinarians.
- ♦ Charitable Funds Committee: Linda Pheasant shared the committee's financial report with this board. There was also discussion of how to attract new Charitable Funds board members.
- Membership Committee: Mary McGreevy has taken over as Membership Chairman. She announced that the current proposed new members had been approved. There was discussion of how to attract new club members.
- Advertising: Richard Basler reported there were fewer Montgomery catalog ads this year.
- Rescue: It was reported that we have had 6 rescues in 2013, with 5 adoptions to date and 1 dog is currently being fostered by Gretchen Quinn. Discussion ensued regarding liability insurance coverage for rescue volunteers. Carl agreed to look into other options regarding liability insurance for Charitable Funds.
- Futurity 2013: Entry numbers for the Futurity and Maturity did not improve this year. Discussion

- ensued regarding whether or not Futurity should continue, and possible remedies for low entries. Options to improve Futurity/Maturity numbers are being considered and will be discussed in future meetings.
- ♦ Treasurer's/Delegate's Report: Carl Ashby provided the board with financial reports for the past year. Dues collection is up this year. Carl proposed selling the current Handbook inventory for \$5 per handbook plus shipping and handling. It was suggested that cookbooks be added to this sale, and the cost is to be determined. The website will be updated with these changes. It was also announced that boutique purchases could now be made and processed by credit card. A discussion was held regarding adding PayPal as an option for paying for the Annual Dinner. Carl's AKC delegate report revealed that entry numbers are down approximately 40,000 entries overall, and litter registrations are down by 6.5%. On a positive note, AOH entries are up.
- ♦ Corresponding Secretary's Report: Bill Kearney reported that 2013 Montgomery weekend preparations were all in order, and that there were 80 reservations for the Annual Meeting and Dinner. Discussion of the Hatboro shows ensued. Motion was made and seconded not to support the Hatboro entry at its Thursday show, beginning in 2014; motion passed.

Old Business:

◆ Facebook and Website Update: John Garahan presented website administrator Carol Kearney's update on the new USKBTC website. It is expected to be on line within the next 6-8 weeks, if there are not too many revisions needed. Several additional projects are planned, once the website is completed and running smoothly. Stephanie Clark is still a USKBTC Facebook administrator. She graciously agreed to post each day's show results for Montgomery weekend. It was also decided that a Membership application would be "pinned" to the USKBTC Facebook page, and a post made encouraging interested visitors to join us.

New Business:

- Board Code of Conduct: The Board Code of Conduct was tabled at this time.
- ◆ **Life Membership**: The board discussed the addition of Life Members in the future.
- ◆ Judges Selection Committee: The proposed list of judges for 2014-2016 Specialties was discussed. Priscilla made a motion to suspend the rules to engage a Sweepstakes judge for the Traveling specialty in Texas in July 2014; it was seconded and passed. After discussion of the Texas judging panel

already engaged, motion was made to ask Vicki Abbott to judge Sweeps in Texas. Motion was seconded and passed. Decision was made to select Specialty Judges for 2014 Specialties from the current list. The committee is looking for volunteers to serve as Futurity judges, and future Sweepstakes judges.

- ♦ Veteran Class Rosettes: After brief discussion, motion was made to award four (4) place ribbons to each Veterans class. It was seconded and passed.
- ◆ Futurity Chair 2014: It was determined that Gigi Lorentz-Reiling will be Futurity Chairman for the coming year.

Judge Selection Process – Nick Fletcher agreed to help current members, Martha Nazak and Priscilla Schwenk

Versatility Awards – Lisa Franklin will now handle this award.

The idea of switching to a raw diet can be a daunting one. Not only are we led to believe by the veterinarian field and pet food industry that we couldn't possibly know how to correctly feed this more natural, species appropriate diet, but there are also the safety warnings and myths that seem to border on paranoia and fear mongering. Then there are the perceived obstacles about the logistics of the diet--ratios, daily portions, avoiding digestive upsets, finding suppliers, etc. Lastly, would be the time commitment. Yes, it is a tad more involved than simply scooping kibble out of a bag, but the reality is that once the dog is switched and vendors found, the diet is incredibly easy and much cheaper than kibble to feed.

Between books, internet forums, Yahoo Groups and Facebook pages, there is a whole world out there ready and willing to answer questions, offer support, and lend aid in one's journey. Feeding raw has many successful routes. From feeding all ground to feeding raw meaty bones, also called prey model, each owner feeds according to what feels right to them. Just like with our own diet, no two people feed raw the same exact way. Feeding ground food is pretty much just that--all meat, bones, and organs are fed ground up together. Prey model is feeding whole pieces to mimic the body of a prey animal--a variety of big, meaty parts from a variety of animals with balance over time. The general ratio rule of thumb is 80/10/10--80% meat, 10% edible bone, and 10% organ, with half of the organ intake being liver. Meat would be muscle, fat, skin, connective tissue, muscular organs such as heart and tongue, as well as things like tracheas and gullets. Examples of organ variety would be liver, kidney, spleen, and pancreas, to name a few.



I've been feeding raw for approximately 13 years. The first 3 years were a mix of prev model, ground, and an occasional meal of The Honest Kitchen. I then switched to a completely prey model diet and haven't looked back. I have assisted countless people with their dog's switch and mentor within the raw feeding community, both online and locally. I have also managed two successful bulk-buying co-ops for raw

feeders--one while living in Austin, TX, and one here in southeastern PA. I love feeding the large, involved "work out" meals because they are just that--a work out. Whole deer spines, rack of ribs, whole legs, etc. I simply feed them in an extra large crate or outside. Face, neck and chest muscles are all used when feverishly working to get the meat off the bone, as well as the complete mental stimulation and exhaustion, creating an extremely happy dog and a wonderful food induced "coma". I will then feed less the next day (or two), sometimes just an egg, so the portion balances out. For me, one of the most rewarding aspects of the diet is seeing my dogs' amazing overall glow and vibrancy as well as their incredible zest regarding each and every meal. Some other benefits I have witnessed are: more restful sleep, reduction/elimination of inappropriate energy, better focus, more endurance, white teeth, healthier coat with more thickness, reduced shedding, increased muscle tone with little to no excess fat, no doggy breath or doggy odor, and MINIMAL stool volume and size. There are certainly plenty more benefits that are experienced by raw feeders every day, with a common one being a complete turnaround for a dog with allergies.

The suggested guideline for daily portions is 2-3% of their weight per day. It will depend on the individual dog's metabolism and activity level as to what is their perfect amount. The "perfect amount" can also vary. During the winter months, when my dogs are more housebound, they need much less than during the summer months when they get biked every day. It is important to monitor the dog's weight and adjust the intake accordingly. Puppies are fed calculating 2-3% of their projected adult weight broken up into 3 meals. They are also notoriously easy to switch and started out right away on variety as they are such a "clean slate". Adult dogs will need a careful transition period to let their system acclimate to the new diet. The most important factor for the switch is to GO SLOWLY. Too much meat variety at first will surely lead to digestive disaster. Organs are also withheld during the switch as they are incredibly nutrient rich and easily lead to a bout of diarrhea (which only lasts until the next meal for a seasoned raw dog). I have always switched to raw, and guided people to switch, cold turkey. I want the body to reap the rewards of complete nutrition on a cellular level right away, and have witnessed a difference within a few days. Chicken is commonly recommended as the 1st meat as it is readily available, fairly inexpensive, and a bland meat. For some dogs, it can be as simple as cutting up a whole chicken into meal-sized portions and handing it to the dog. Others might need more assistance and patience at first. When this is the case, some have found success with quickly searing a boneless cut (all bones are fed raw!) to bring out the fancy smell and juices, or a meal or two with a light sprinkle of Parmesan cheese. If the bone is a little confusing at first for the dog, breaking it up into pieces with a mallet or hammer can make it less overwhelming.

Stay with the 1st meat until the dog is showing you he is well adjusted (readily eating, no digestive upsets, and regular, firm stool). As stated earlier, the typical recommen-

dation is at least a week or two. Adding the 2nd meat (many do pork) can be as simple as offering it to the dog at the next meal, or can be broken down more slowly over several meals. When I switched adult dogs in the past, I alternated the 2nd meat every other day, but I've known people who stopped the 1st meat for several days when introducing the 2nd meat. Usually after a month, the dog's system is much more acceptable to variety and new meat intros are not needed. Having a mentor during this time is quite beneficial to answer any questions and helps the owner not feel so alone during the switch. This is where the Internet forums come in so handy.

Somewhere around the 4-5 week mark, when both owner and dog are a little more experienced with the diet, organ is introduced. As previously stated, since they are very nutrient rich and can create loose stools very easily, it is important to go very slow when introducing them. Organs can have an "Eww" factor, even for the most seasoned raw fed dog. It is not uncommon to hear of them being fed ground, hidden in something the dog LOVES, fed frozen, or "doctored". Luckily, they only need 10% total intake, so some people even feed bite-sized portions every day.

Without a doubt, an important appliance for the raw feeder is an extra freezer, as finding sources is another factor of the diet. An extra freezer enables one to take advantage of bulk buying, stocking up on food sales, maintaining variety, etc. Here again, the Yahoo Groups and Facebook are great resources, either by joining the supplier list or finding a local raw feeding co-op. Asking the meat department in the supermarket where they order their meat can provide you with a possible source as many meat purveyors sell to the public. Hunting season is another great opportunity as that is all free meat and bones. Finding a deer processor willing to give away all the trimmings and bones is a HUGE score, then asking them if they know anyone who processes other farm animals (cow, bison, goats, sheep, etc.) may lead you to another source. The key is to never stop looking, never stop asking. It will pay off. Even after 13 years, I still am always on the lookout for new/better suppliers for cheaper meat and more red meat variety. Ideally, the diet should include as much red meat as possible since it is more prototypically correct for the canine carnivore. As I found more red meat suppliers and fed less and less poultry, I noticed an even more marked improvement in my dogs. Poultry is now almost non-existent in my dogs' diet.

Many people ask me what I do for treats. I don't really do "just because" treats. With all of the chewing fun they have with bones, they are mentally happy and don't even look for treats. For training treats, I usually do cut up string cheese, but one could use anything since treats are such an insignificant contribution to the overall diet.

When it comes to the veterinarian I choose to hire for the care for my animals, I don't really discuss diet with them. It is not their choice as to how I feed my dogs, much like how my doctor is not my nutritionist. If they don't support my choices, I take my dogs and my money elsewhere and find a vet who respects me as a pet owner. If your vet or trainer openly said they hated your Kerry blue terrier,

you would look elsewhere, yes? The same is true for the diet. Find a vet who is supportive, there are plenty out there



While the much talked about risk factor of bones getting stuck or perforating the intestine can happen, the reality is it isn't very common. Usually the cause is feeding incorrect bones. Cooked bones are a huge culprit of these stories, as well as some of the weight bearing bones that can splinter as the dog is chewing. A dog's digestive tract is much more acidic and designed to digest raw bones. As for the safety warnings, many raw feeders simply don't understand all the fear and scare tactics surrounding this diet. Safe food handling is common sense, whether for us or our pets, and people overlook the fact that the same safety warnings are in place about handling kibble. No extra precautions are needed and there isn't any greater risk from feeding raw. Period.

Meet the Breed Banners Available!

For those clubs who plan to host or participate in a "Meet the Breed" type event, the USKBTC has banners available. The display, which appeared in December at the "Meet the Breed" event before Eukanuba, consists of 3 canvas panels, each one 2 feet wide and 8 feet long with grommets at the top. Hung together, they display our versatile Kerry blues participating in many various activities: herding, therapy work, obedience, agility, and more.

These banners can be shipped to any chapter club to create an impressive presentation of our wonderful, fun-loving breed. Raw Feeding - Easier Than You Think By Reita Nicholson

Raw feeding is easier than you think it might be. When I first started, it was done with some doubt if I could feed raw or if my dogs would eat it? That was around five years ago and it has been a very good experience. Young puppies to older dogs benefit from eating raw.

The way I started was to put a couple ounces with their kibble. The dogs never had a problem with the raw being added. There was never an upset stomach or diarrhea with any of my dogs. Chicken is always a good meat to start with, most dogs eat it readily. Soon I was feeding primarily raw. It's an easy process to do, I weigh my dogs raw with each feeding so that I can monitor if they need more or less. They eagerly wait for their dishes to be set before them.

You can feed your dog a variety of raw meat and raw meaty bones. My dogs enjoy beef, pork, chicken, turkey, quail, venison, rabbit, salmon, sardines and any other raw that I can get my hands on. They also get organ meats, but this is not served as a meal alone, it is a smaller portion of the feeding (about 10%) and not every day.

Yes dogs can eat bones, and they should be raw; always remember never cooked bones and never defrost your raw in the microwave. When bones are cooked they splinter easier and can cause problems. Chicken thighs, wings, back, rib bones, and necks are very easy for the dogs to eat. If you are concerned with the size of the bones, you can use a hammer and crack the bones before feeding. Pork ribs are always a treat which the dogs enjoy chewing and eating. Cut the ribs from the chicken breasts before cooking and place them in your dog's dish.

Once it is out that you feed raw to your dogs, the neighbors will bring their older frozen meat to you when they are cleaning out their freezer. When they have a new deer for the season, what's left of the old comes to our place. I ask the local hunters to please send any unwanted venison my way. Check your local grocery to see if they are having a meat sale, you can pick up some good bargains that way. I buy beef from a distributor that butchers and packages it for the dogs. You can locate distributors on the internet and there are numerous sites about raw feeding. A good book is Raw Dog Food: Make It Easy For You and Your Dog, by Carina Beth MacDonald.

I'm sure a lot of you wonder about the dangers of feeding raw. As long as common sense is used you should not have a problem. After preparing their dinner,

clean up your area and wash your hands. I would do the same if I was handling kibble.

There are so many benefits of feeding raw that I hope I can mention them all: Beautiful clean teeth from the raw meaty bones and chunks of raw. Coats that shine, more vitality, better stamina. Less volume in stools and less often. They maintain a great weight and wonderful muscle tone. Well check-ups from the vet come back excellent. My dogs have clean beards and good smelling breath, no doggie breath from dirty teeth. There is not a problem with keeping them clean when they eat raw. Also raw feeding is less expensive than what you may think.

I want to take this opportunity to thank both Sara Garthly and Reita Nicholson (Kerrisel) for sharing their knowledge and experiences about Feeding Raw.

Miss Squiggy Goes to School

Miss Squiggy has gone back to school! She and her sidekick (Jaimie Ashby) are participating in the Pet

Responsibility Program in the **Guilford County** Schools, Established in Moore County, North Carolina about 7 years ago and quickly spreading to other areas, this program consists of six fun, wellplanned lessons that teach children about the basic needs of animals, how to keep themselves and their animals safe



and healthy, and the importance of having pets spayed or neutered. Students also learn ways to safely handle encounters with unknown animals, how to share the information they learn with others, what it means to be a responsible person and how the decisions individuals make can affect entire communities.



Pet overpopulation is a serious and growing problem in many areas of the country, leading to overcrowded animal shelters, increased animal abuse and neglect, increased animal attacks and unnecessarily high rates of euthanasia. Through the Pet Responsibility Program, students learn that by talking to their friends and families about the importance of having pets spayed or neutered they can help solve the problem of overpopulation. The six week program has a specific curriculum focusing on being a responsible owner, the welfare of dogs AND cats, and the importance of spaying or neutering. There's also a great video from AKC that covers things such as how to approach a dog and what to do if you see a stray dog.

The therapy dogs come in for the last session, and they totally take over the class. Miss Squiggy does some of her tricks (which she AL-SO does on her nursing home visits), and the kids all love her. It's tough to keep this last session to just one hour. because the kids have tons of questions



and enjoy interacting with the dogs. It's an excellent activity for Miss Squiggy, who at 14 years of age absolutely adores the attention! I cannot tell you how much BOTH of us have enjoyed participating in this program. If anyone has any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me for more information about this great program!

- 2. Thirty (30) days after publication in BLUEPRINTS, your application and any member's comments will be submitted to the Board of Governors for consideration.
- 3. You will be promptly notified, in writing, of the Board's action.
- 4. You will be provided with a copy of the approved Constitution and Bylaws.

This Membership process can take up to six (6) months or more, due to the Quarterly publication of BLUEPRINTS, please be patient. Note that your check may be cashed prior to your being elected to membership. This does not automatically elect you to membership. If for any reason, you are not elected to membership; your application fee will be refunded.

THE UNITED STATES KERRY BLUE TERRIER CLUB CODE OF ETHICS

This document defines the ethical standards to which we ascribe as a condition of membership in the United Stated Kerry Blue Terrier Club (USKBTC). Membership is a privilege conferred by the Board of Governors, acting for the Membership, upon those individuals who meet the high standards set forth in the Club Constitution and Bylaws and this Code. As members, we are individually charged with complying with this code and demanding similar compliance of all other members. We must hold the interest of the Kerry Blue Terrier superior to our own in exercising the responsibilities that accompany the privileges of membership.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A MEMBER

- Members of the USKBTC, as Stewards to the breed, have the obligation to protect and serve the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier at all times. A member's every action should reflect credit on themselves, the USKBTC and, above all, the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- > The approved standard for the breed is the fundamental imperative guiding our actions. Members have the obligation to protect and serve these standards as a condition of membership.
- Members must be familiar with and comply with the rules of the American Kennel Club (AKC); the Constitution and By-laws of the USKBTC; and (as appropriate) the rules established by any member club of the USKBTC.
- Members will observe the highest standards of conduct and sportsmanship at all times. Whether as a breeder, exhibitor, or spectator, they shall conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the Kerry Blue Terrier, dogs in general, and the sport of showing dogs.
- Members shall maintain the highest standards of health and sanitation for their own Kerry Blue Terriers, as well as for any other animals in their possession or entrusted to their care. They shall demand the same high standards of others, members and non-members alike.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BREEDER

A Breeder shall:

- Be guided at all times by the approved standard for the Kerry Blue Terrier and shall consider breeding only those specimens that conform to the standard.
- When contemplating breeding a litter or providing the services of a stud dog, strive toward maintaining breed type and producing dogs of exceptional quality, temperament, and condition. Breeding or supporting breeding to a lesser standard is not acceptable.
- Use for breeding only those dogs that are healthy and free from serious congenital and hereditary defects. Refrain from further use, any bitch or stud dog that has developed such a health problem or produced any serious inherited defects detrimental to the offspring and the overall well being of the breed.
- Not use a bitch for breeding prior to reaching eighteen (18) months of age (preferably 24 months) or older than eight (8) years of age. A bitch should not be bred more than two (2) out of three (3) consecutive heat cycles, nor produce more than five (5) litters in her lifetime. Recognizing the variations in heat cycles and sizes of litters, valid exceptions may exist, however it is incumbent on the breeder to exercise good judgment in exercising such exceptions.
- Not sell puppies to pet shops either outright or on consignment; supply puppies for auctions, raffles, or other such activities; refrain from selling to persons whose intention (either known or suspected) is to resell or use the puppy in a breeding program not complying with this code of ethics. The breeder shall ensure that the prospective buyer is prepared to provide the same degree of care required of members of the USKBTC. The Code of Ethics should be provided and discussed with potential buyers as part of a thorough screening process. All buyers should be encouraged to become members of the USKBTC and member clubs.
- Promptly apply for AKC registration of the litter. Puppies should not be sold prior to reaching ten (10) weeks of age (preferably 12 weeks). The sale of every dog shall include a signed registration or registration application (Blue Slip), and a four-generation pedigree. Any exceptions to these requirements, or valid restrictions or limitations imposed as conditions to the sale (e.g., no breeding) must be agreed to in writing by both parties at the time of sale. It is strongly recommended that a written agreement accompany all sales. Buyers should be provided with assistance and support in the setting of ears and in learning proper grooming. If the buyer is not located in the same area, the breeder should make arrangements with another USKBTC member in that area to assist the new owner.
- Provide with each sale, a record of dated and types of immunization given, immunizations required, and veterinary health records. Instructions should be provided, preferably in writing, on diseases and hereditary factors related to the breed, proper medical care, feeding, and grooming. Providing a copy of the current USKBTC Handbook represents a means of conveying this type of information, and is a sound investment on the part of the breeder. No puppy should be sold without either temporary or permanent protection against distemper-hepatitis and parvo. Puppies should have a veterinary examination, and worming if required, before sale.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of stock, matings, pedigrees, show records, and transfers. Breeders are responsible for conducting research on their pedigrees to ensure correct ancestry, accurate spelling of names and correct registration numbers. Breeders should be familiar with and comply with all record keeping requirements required by the AKC. Litter registration applications must be correct and promptly requested. Individual puppy registration should be completed in a timely manner.
- > Shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or other misrepresentations with respect to their own breeding. They shall not malign others by making false or misleading statements regarding another member's dogs, breeding practices, or person. Advertising should not be worded to attract undesirable buyers nor encourage raising dogs for profit.
- Consider the growing problems related to excess dogs ending up in animal shelters and should exercise sound judgment and prudent restraint in their breeding programs. Litters should be limited to numbers that are consistent with achieving a sound breeding program and the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier.
- **>** Be prepared to assume lifetime responsibility for any litter produced.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN EXHIBITOR OR HANDLER

- Act professionally at all times in caring for and exhibiting any dog in your charge.
- Do not engage in any questionable contact with judges prior to exhibiting under them.
- Comply with AKC Rules and Regulations for Dog Shows, Obedience Trials, Field Trials, and The Guidelines for Dog Show Judges.
- Exhibit or handle only those dogs that conform as closely as possible to the approved standard.
- Do not indulge in the practice of making "kennel majors", or exhibiting filler dogs that they know themselves to be unworthy of championships, for the purpose of finishing dogs. Such practices lessen the meaning and value of a championship and do not serve the breed.

IV. ENFORCEMENT


- > The USKBTC expects adherence to this Code of Ethics and blatant disregard of these standards will not be condoned. Violations of the standards are not in the best interests of the Club or the breed. Such behavior can serve as a cause of imposing discipline or terminating membership if charges are brought before the Board of Governors in accordance with the procedures as defined in Article VI (Discipline) of the USKBTC Constitution and Bylaws.
- Article VI addresses the specific procedures for proffering charges; the hearing process; and the rights of the parties involved. Each member is expected to be fully familiar with this very important provision of the By-laws.


